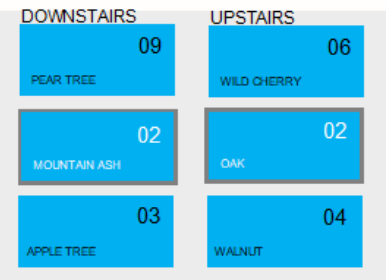
SECOND FLOOR



FIRST FLOOR



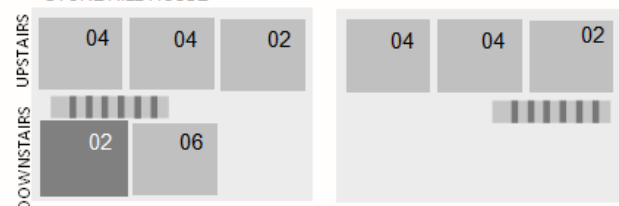
MURRAY HOUSE

Centre Rules
