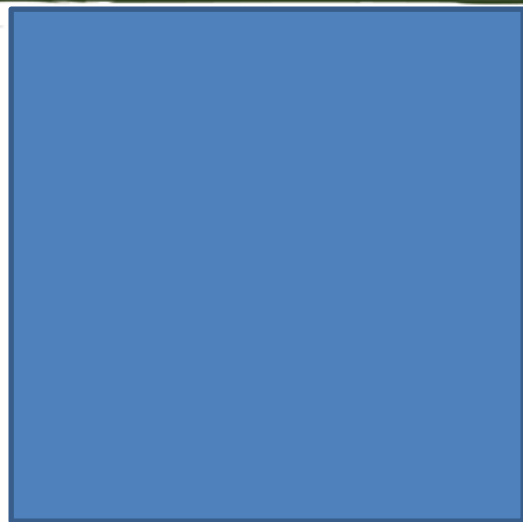

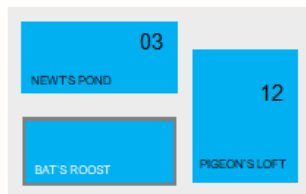
ADULT'S DORM

The William Amory— Bears and Otters

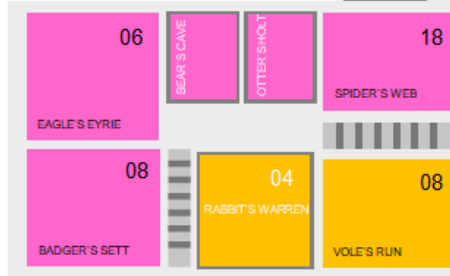
Bilbrook— Rabbits and Hares

Perton— Bats, Newts, Wolves, Fox's, Ants, Mountain Ash & oak

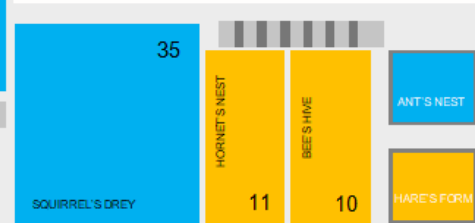
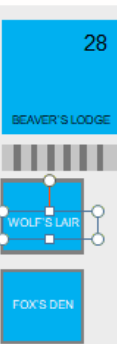
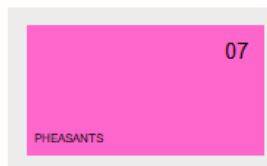
SECOND FLOOR



FIRST FLOOR

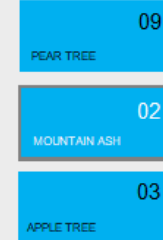


GROUND FLOOR

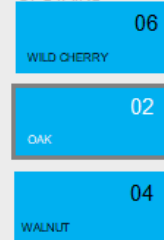

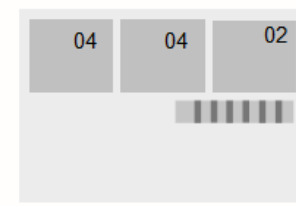
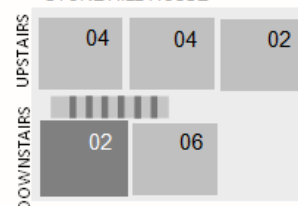
