# Money

- £100 max
- Cash only
- Must be handed in an envelope to the student's adult lead before we leave PMS. Students should keep the amount they require for Monday in a purse in their rucksack.
- Money will be kept by the student's adult lead. A 'bank' will be available each morning at breakfast to collect the amount of money they'd like for that day. Please discuss this with your child before the trip.

# Mobile Phones

- Students will not be allowed mobile phones for the duration of the trip.
- If you child wishes to take their phone, it must be handed in to their adult lead before we leave PMS. Chn will have an allocated 1 hour a day to use their phone when we are altogether in a communal area. **Monday- during dinner, Tuesday and Wednesday- during breakfast**. Phones will then be kept locked away in their adult lead's room.
- If students need to contact the school phone whilst in London, they will have a card with the phone number on and can ask the activity centre or shops to contact the mobile.
- If parents wish to make contact with the group, you will be able to message the school mobile phone **07444369084** (which will be held by Mrs Jones) or contact the school office.
