HOW DID YOU FEEL WHEN YOU FIRST BECAME A TEACHER?

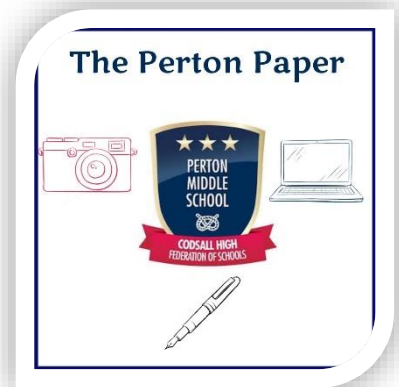
It was a nerve wrecking experience at first, but it was also very exciting.

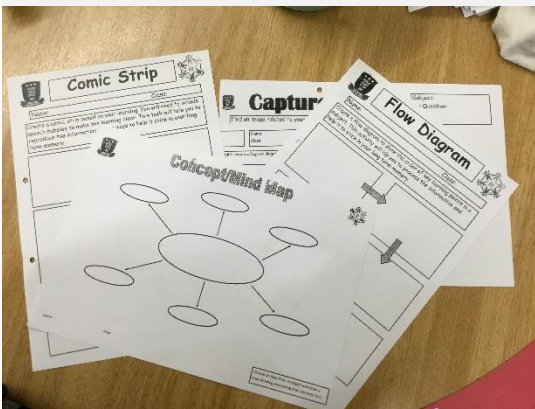
MRS SHELLEY'S HOMEWORK CLUB

ALADDIN

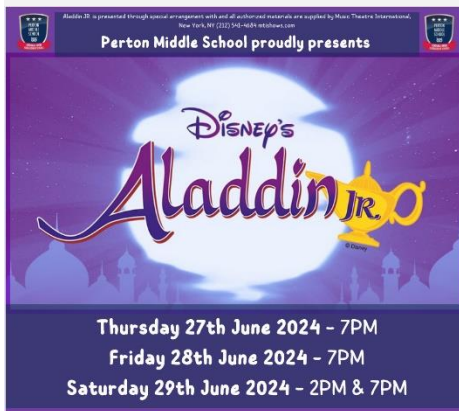
As you might have heard Perton, Middle School will be performing Aladdin JR in June 2024. There will be many roles.

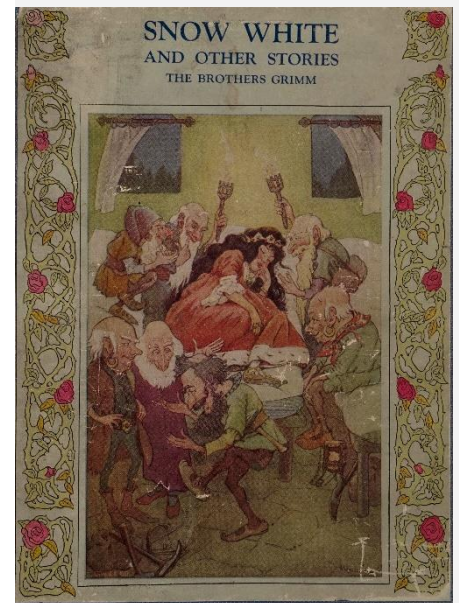


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
