Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to Perton Middle School.

We are delighted that you have chosen Perton Middle School for your child and we are looking forward to working in partnership with you on the next stage of your child's educational journey.

All year 4 students are invited to Perton Middle School to attend an induction morning on **Wednesday 26th June**. Students will be required to wear their current school PE kit and the aim of the session is to meet students from other schools prior to the announcement, on the 2nd July, of form groups for September. Students will take part in activities in order to get to know others who will be in their year group.

Students from **Perton Primary Academy** and **Perton First School** will walk to Perton Middle School from their first schools, arriving with us for about 9:30 a.m. **St Chad's** students will be collected by minibus from outside the Co-Op in Pattingham between 8:30 and 8.45 a.m. If your child is joining us from a different school, they should be brought to reception for 9:30 a.m. and collected at 12:00 p.m.

Students will leave us at midday and head back to their first school. **St Chad's** students will be dropped back to school at approximately 12:15 p.m. so should bring a packed lunch on that day to eat on their return.

Ahead of the full transition day, we invite you to join us for Induction Evening on **Tuesday 2nd July** at 6:00 p.m. Parents, carers and students are welcome to attend this evening where we will display uniform, share general information about school life and announce form groups for September. There will also be time to meet your child's new form tutor who will show you your child's form room and answer any questions you may have.

Prior to this meeting it is important that you log onto <u>https://www.pertonmiddle.com/2024</u> and complete the data collection sheet. At the end of the page, you will be asked to let us know how many seats you would like to reserve at the induction evening and whether your child will require a school lunch on the 3<sup>rd</sup> July paid for by the school. # Wednesday 3rd July Full Transition Day
