Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: Instrumental Tuition 2024 -25

From the start of next half term, we are delighted to be able to offer peripatetic music lessons again. Unfortunately, due to staff change over in Music, we have been delayed in this process, but are now able to confirm their participation.

Instrumental lessons will begin week commencing Monday 11th November from which time your child will be asked to arrive at a specified time/day according to the timetable of the teacher (all times and places of lessons will be displayed on the Music display board near the Art room) and it is your child's responsibility to check this information weekly.

Lessons will be 20 minutes long and occur during the school day; teachers rotate lessons every week to minimize any time spent out of curriculum lessons. Some lessons will also take place during lunchtime and lunchtime passes can be obtained from Mrs Jessel.

The cost of music tuition is £40 per half term per instrument (payable at the start of each half term) which should be paid via Parent Pay.

You will find attached to this letter a Music Tuition Agreement to be signed by yourself and your child and returned to school by Wednesday 6th November at the latest.

Perton Middle School Music Tuition Agreement

The school agrees to:

- Provide music lessons of 20-minute duration.
- Students to be taught in groups of up to 4, at the teacher's discretion.
- Provide lessons for 28 weeks per academic year with a guaranteed minimum of 26.
- Notify parents if a student should miss three lessons in any term.

Parents agree to:

- Pay the agreed cost of lessons/tuition, payable half termly promptly.
- Give the school a minimum of half a term's notice to cancel lessons/tuition. (You will be required to pay the cost of lessons/tuition during the notice period even if you decide not to attend the lessons/tuition.)
- Notify the school if a student is to be absent from a lesson.

Students agree to:

- Check lesson time and arrive promptly at the commencement of their tuition, having first excused themselves from their normal curriculum lesson.
- Take care of his/her instrument and keep it in good working order at all times.
- Practise regularly to lay the foundations of understanding and capability.
- When indicated by the instrumental teacher that sufficient progress has been made, attend Orchestra and/or Band.
